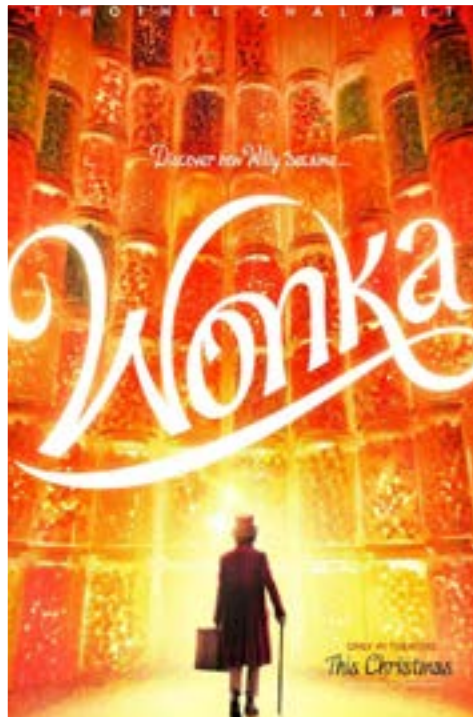

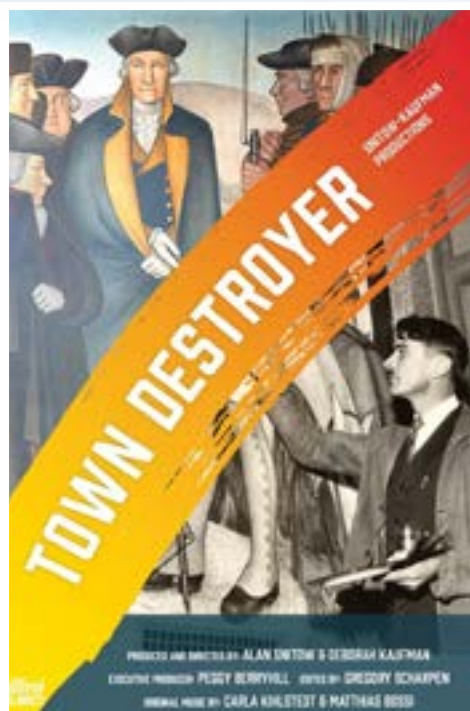

Dear Friends of the Chatham Orpheum Theater


